Q: What is a Personal Assistant (PA)?

A: A PA is someone who is paid to support a person in their home and out in the community.

Q: Who can be a PA?

A: Anyone who has a desire to support and care for people can be a PA.

Q: What does a PA role involve?

A: Every role is different because each person who needs support is different, lots of people like to have support to go out and about, others need help at home or help with personal care.

Q: How does it work?

Q: What is the rate of pay?

A: This often depends on the role, we recommend hourly rates of pay of £9 to £11 per hour.
